**GENERAL RULES OF THE RALLY**

- The Federation, its officers and servants accept no responsibility for accidents, loss or damage to any person, exhibit or property.
- The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry and to vary or cancel any event or the number of prizes in any event according to the number of exhibitors or competitors. No exhibit shown in previous Rallies may be exhibited.
- The decision of the Judge is final.
- Signed objections must be submitted to the Chairman before 3.00pm on the day of the Rally, except for Main Ring competitions, which must be within 15 minutes of the end of the competition.
- All persons taking part in the Rally must be card holding members of a Suffolk Young Farmers' Club. Any Club, which is found to be represented by a person who does not comply with the above, will be disqualified. Competitors may be required to show their membership cards at any time during the day.
- Those identified as National Competitions and therefore National Rules should be read in conjunction with any other rules for these classes.
- No water fights at all including water pistols will be allowed. Stonham Barn is open to the public and it is not fair on them – BE WARNED!! IF ANY PERSON/CLUB BREAK THIS RULE THEIR CLUB WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FROM THE RALLY AND 10 POINTS DEDUCTED FROM THEIR TOTAL.
- All Pre Rally entries to have a card with them listing:-
  - Name
  - Club
  - Age Group (Junior/Senior)
  - Competition

AGE GROUPS

JUNIOR competitors to be 16 years of age, or under, on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2009. SENIOR competitors to be 30 years of age, or under, on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2009.

Rally Cup

- Points will be awarded on the basis of the number of entries in the class. IE if there are 20 entries in the class points will be scored from 20 for first place down to 1 for last place.
- The points awarded per club in each class will be totalled to arrive at the position gained by each club overall. Competitions points will then be awarded for the position gained overall on the basis of 12, 10, 8, 6, 4 and 2.

The awards for winning cups are as follows:

Senior Rally Trophy (awarded to the senior club with most points overall)

Junior Rally Trophy (awarded to the junior club with most points overall)

Gary Hopkins Memorial Trophy (Junior and Senior) awarded to the winning junior and senior clubs in the Buggy Race

Rally Contribution Cup – awarded to the member(s) who have contributed most to the successful running of the Rally

**Class Rules:**

- Exhibits that have been washed or are soiled will be disqualified
- Any entry that does not conform to the Schedule will be disqualified
- The sizes specified will be strictly adhered to.
- Any exhibits left on the site prior to the Rally will be at the exhibitors own risk.
- All exhibits to be staged by 10am on Rally Day
- At the Judges discretion a competitor may be required to demonstrate a skill involved in producing an entry or may be questioned by the Judge about the process of how an item was made.
- Any entries removed before 4.30pm will have penalty points deducted.
- No eating of, or tampering with any exhibits will be tolerated. Any clubs caught doing this will be disqualified entirely.

**NFYFC COMPETITION – MY COUNTY PICTURE**

**R U L E S**

1. **ELIGIBILITY** - The competitors must be 30 years of age or under on 1 September 2009 and a full member of a Club affiliated to Suffolk YFC.

**2 ENTRIES PER CLUB**

2. **PROCEDURE** – Competitors will be required to produce a water colour painting to the theme ‘My Home County’. The artwork should carry a title of no more than six words. The title should be within A3 size.

The artwork is to be submitted to the NFYFC fixed to foam core board (sometimes known as Foamboard Display Board and readily available from good stationers and art supplies retailers). The artwork may be mounted, but must **not** be framed. Entries submitted that are framed will be disqualified and not judged.

Size of board not to exceed A3 (420 X 297 mm). The title or the artwork is to be on the board and must be within the A3 size allowed.

The impression must be the artist’s own work and must not have been published anywhere prior to the county round of the competition.

The artist's name, County Federation and membership number must be securely fixed to the reverse of the board on which the entry is mounted.

It is a condition of entry to this competition that the artist accepts and grants the NFYFC permission to reproduce the artwork and publish it for public relations and promotional purposes. It is anticipated that some, but not all entries, will be scanned and published on the NFYFC website.

1. **ELIGIBILITY** - The competitors must be 30 years of age or under on 1 September 2009 and a full member of a Club affiliated to Suffolk YFC.
  
2. **PROCEDURE** –  
Clubs to produce a float to promote their club. These floats must also promote the Golden Jubilee of Suffolk Young Farmers. The float must be in line with the Health and Safety regulations set by NFU Mutual insurance.

CLUBS SHOULD SUBMIT A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FLOAT AND IT'S CHARACTERS AND INCLUDE A REPORT ON YOUR CLUB. TO BE READ WHILST THE FLOATS ARE IN THE RING.

County will provide the trailer for the floats to be staged on. These will be Ifor Williams style flatbed trailers and will be equipped with all the equipment necessary to meet the Health and Safety rules. Drivers for the floats will be provided.

It is forbidden to throw or squirt anything from the floats. Any Clubs misbehaving in any way will be immediately disqualified from the day's activities. There will be a specific time in the programme for floats and water/flour fights DEPENDENT ON PERMISSION FROM THE VENUE.

1. **ELIGIBILITY** - The competitors must be 30 years of age or under on 1 September 2009 and a full member of a Club affiliated to Suffolk YFC.

**3 ENTRIES PER CLUB**

2. **PROCEDURE** –

The competitor will be required to produce 3 photographs, 6” x 4”, mounted on an A3 board to the theme “*Suffolk Young Farmers Golden Jubilee – a celebration*”.

Photographs can be captured using film or Digital photography.

If Digital photography is used as the capture method the photographs **MUST NOT** be digitally enhanced using photographic software on a computer. The preferred printing method would be to print the photos from the memory card using a commercial photo machine.

If a photo machine is used the appropriate size can be selected and the image can be turned into black & white, sepia or colour but no other alterations can be done for example cropping images, brightness/contrast, colour restoration/balance or any method which would digitally alter the photo quality.

Photos should be self explanatory but a short sentence or title under each photo would be allowed (10 words maximum) or a three sentence script (30 word maximum) anywhere on the A3 board. Text should be separate and **NOT** within a photograph or this will be perceived as being digitally enhanced.

**2 ENTRIES PER CLUB**

2. **PROCEDURE** – Each floral art piece to be created individually as follows:-

***JUNIOR:*** Subject: *A Church Window Display to the theme "My Home County" – An Exhibit*

***INTERMEDIATE:*** Subject: *A Pew End to the theme "My Home County" – An Exhibit*

***SENIOR:*** Subject: *A Hand Tied Posey to the theme "My Home County" – An Exhibit*

Each individual exhibit will be displayed within an area measuring 75cm wide x 60cm deep (no limit on height) to their best advantage. Accessories are allowed to complement the theme; no background will be provided – the display is to be viewed from all sides and therefore backboards are not allowed; table covering will be in white, however competitors may wish to use their own tablecovering as an accessory. NFFYC will provide a label for each exhibit.

**All exhibits must be the unaided work of the competitors and must be assembled in the hall.** If oasis is to be used, new pieces must be used on the day of the competition.

During the period of the competition, competitors must not communicate directly or indirectly with any person other than Judges or Stewards, under penalty of instant disqualification. **No other person, other than the competitors, will be allowed in the hall.**

**TIMING** – Allowance of one hour, with a further ten minutes to check that arrangements have not been disturbed during cleaning-up operations

An **EXHIBIT** is composed of natural plant material, with or without accessories, contained within a space as specified in a show schedule. Backgrounds, bases, containers, drapes, exhibit titles and mechanics may always be included in an exhibit, unless otherwise stated. More than one placement may always be included, unless otherwise stated. In all exhibits natural plant material should predominate.

An **ACCESSORY** is a) anything other than natural plant material in an exhibit, such as coral, feathers, sea fan, shells, stones b) natural plant material which has been tooled or crafted to resemble non-plant forms, e.g. birds nest, corn dolly, wooden figurine.

Accessories, e.g. cakes, figurines, needlework, may be decorated in anyway but greater credit should be given for the use of natural plant material where appropriate.

\*\*\*\*\*

NAFAS Rules state that disqualification will take place for the following reasons:-

- a) Failure to comply with any specific requirements of a class as stated in a show schedule, i.e. the measurements or the components.
  - b) Inclusion of fresh plant material that does not have roots or the cut ends of stems in water or water-retaining material. Exceptions: Air Plants, Cacti, Fruits, Grass Turf, Lichen, Moss, Succulents, Vegetables and long lasting plant material (including strong fibrous stems) which will remain turgid for the duration of a show. (Definition of turgid – the state of firmness of plant tissue resulting from adequate moisture, causing the plant cells to be fully expanded).
  - c) Inclusion of artificial plant material (unless specifically allowed by a show schedule).

3. **TIMING** – Allowance of one hour, with a further ten minutes to check that arrangements have not been disturbed during cleaning-up operations.

4. **EXHIBITS**

Exhibits must remain in position throughout the day of the competition. Any entry removed before the Presentation of Awards will be disqualified.

**2 ENTRIES PER CLUB**

2. **PROCEDURE** –

Materials: Large coke bottle 1-2L, a cork from a wine bottle, an old bicycle inner tube (Preferably with the thinner type of valve), a drill, and a bicycle pump.

Instructions: Cut out the valve from a bicycle inner tube, leaving a small circle of rubber around the bottom. (Keep the rest of the inner tube to make a catapult on another day). Check the length of your valve against the cork to make sure the valve pokes through enough so the pump can be attached. If not cut the cork down with a sharp kitchen vegetable knife. Using a drill that has a diameter equal to your valve carefully and slowly drill through the centre of the cork. Insert the valve into the cork (A smear of vaseline or cooking oil may help). Fill a coke bottle with 1/3 water and firmly insert your cork-valve assembly. Make a launching sled for the rocket. We dug a couple of bits of wood into the mud and propped them up with stones in a "V" shape to support the bottle. Stiff cardboard would also suffice. Finally check there are no aircraft above and attach your pump. Get pumping until it takes off. The bottle will definitely go over the fence into your neighbours garden or on a roof so make sure you have a spare available.

Hints: Attach wings to the bottle to make the space shuttle challenger! Slightly adjust the water level for optimum performance.
